HOWTO REGISTER FOR ONLINE COURSES





Visit smolny.org and click Apply on the course page.



Create an account on the GHEA21 Course Portal.



Wait for the email containing your temporary password to access the GHEA21 Course Portal.



Log in to the system with the temporary password and your birthdate.



Set a new password.



Apply for courses through the portal.

Upload your Statement of interest and click Submit.



Check the status of your application under Registered Courses – Pending.



Your application will be under review for some time.




Once your application is approved, commit to the course.





1. Visit www.smolny.org.









We use the GHEA21 portal for course registration. This is a new platform we have not used before, so you will need to create a new account to apply for a course, even if you have taken SBB courses in the past.

- 6. Submit the form to complete your registration.







The course introduces students to a relatively recent tradition of philosophy that is dominant in the English-speaking world and gaining popularity elsewhere. This tradition focuses on a radical criticism of historically established philosophical (metaphysical) concepts from the perspectives of logic, language, and function, as well as on elaborating formal principles in various fields of human activity. Students will learn why philosophy of language has become the methodological foundation of this philosophical tradition. The course will acquaint them both with the ideas of the recognized classics of analytic philosophy (G. Frege, B. Russell, L. Wittgenstein, J. Austin, and others) and with contemporary philosophers (W. V. O. Quine, H. Putnam, D. Davidson, M. Dummett, R. Brandom, and others), whose work is characterized by a synthesis of formal-logical analysis and American pragmatism.
